

To my GP practice and hospital clinic:

Please would you note in my medical records that I would rather be seen by a medical doctor than by a Physician Associate (or Anaesthesia Associate or Surgical Care Practitioner) and ensure this is made clear to staff each time I check in for an appointment.

If I am coming because of a new medical problem, I do not want a Physician Associate to be the first person to diagnose me. If my doctor later feels it is appropriate for me to be seen by a Physician Associate (for example in a follow up appointment) I would like an explanation and for my consent to be sought. I agree with the British Medical Association that patients should always know who is treating them, and when this is or is not a medically qualified doctor.
